### Stay Adjusted

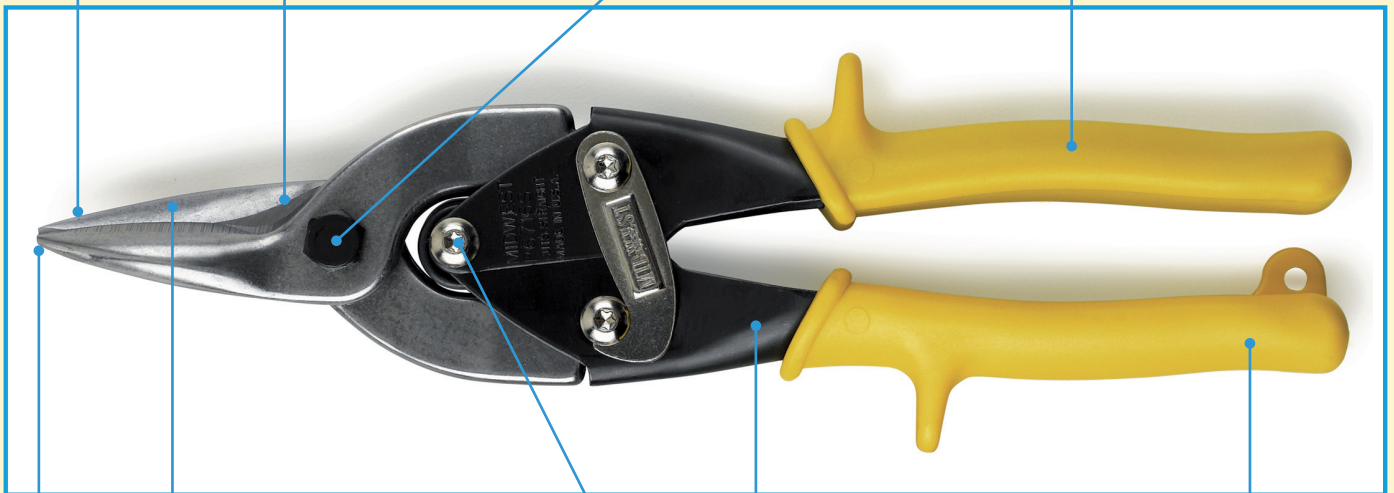
Grade-8 hardened center pivot bolt threaded into back blade maintains adjustment for optimum cutting.

### No Slip or Scar

40 blade serrations per 1" (2.54 cm) grip without slip or scar.

### Comfortable Grips

Soft and durable copolymer grips won't twist or wear through.



### Unbreakable Blades

Hot drop-forged molybdenum alloy steel blades are virtually unbreakable and provide long-lasting edge life. Withstand a force over 7,000 pounds by putting pressure on the shanks.

### No-Bend Handles

Heavy gauge steel handles maximize force into cutting power at blades.

### Easy To Grip/Close

Ergonomically optimum 5.5" (140 mm) handle opening.

### Easiest To Use

Full length pinch to point cuts up to 1,24 mm Cold-Rolled Sheet Metal or 0,78 mm Stainless Steel Sheet Metal, with less than 80 lbs. (36 kg.) of hand pressure.

### Heavy-Duty Spring

Unbreakable double overwind spring is guaranteed forever. Exceeded 120,000 cutting strokes without failure.
